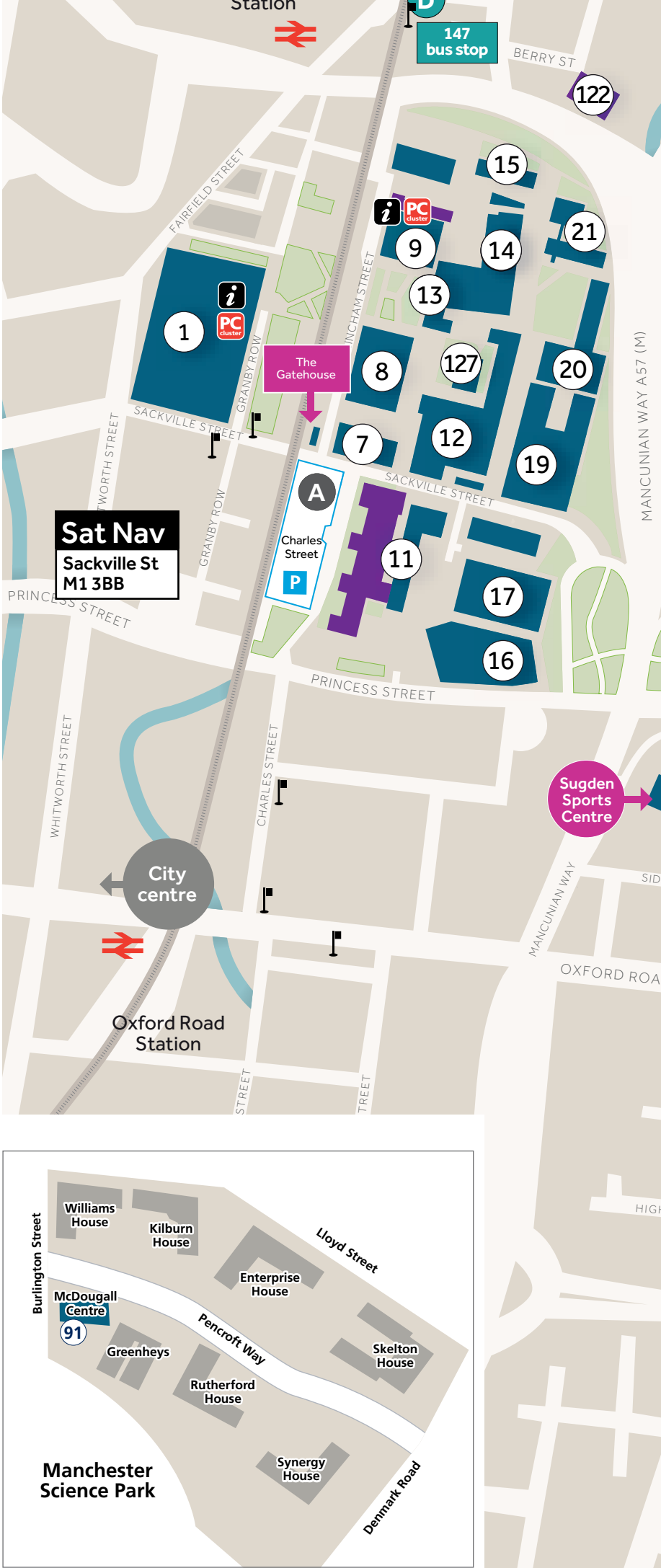

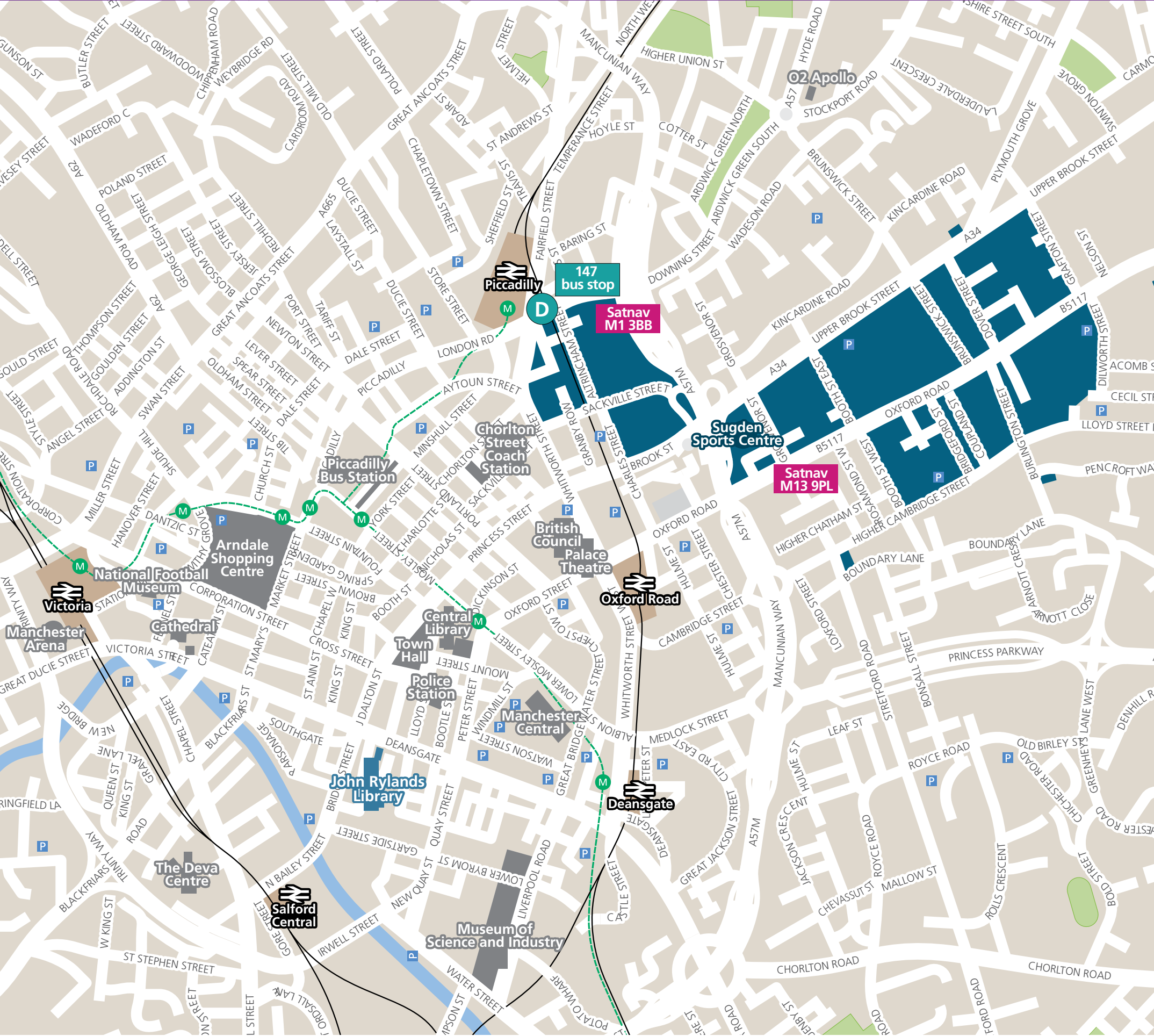

TRAVELLING TO THE UNIVERSITY

The University takes its social responsibility and relations with the local community seriously and aims to reduce its impact on the environment through its sustainability policies. Information on sustainable travel options is provided below and journey planning help is available at my.tfgm.com

RAIL
Manchester is well served by national and regional services.

Piccadilly Station is a 2 minute walk from north campus and is linked to south campus by the Oxford Road Link (147 bus) shuttle bus which runs every 10 minutes, Mon – Fri, from Stop D, Fairfield Street www.route147.co.uk

Oxford Road Station is within 10/15min walking distance of both the north and south campuses. The route between the station and the south campus is also served by a vast number of buses (see below).

Victoria Station is located on the north side of the city and the University can be accessed via a combination of tram and bus/walk (see relevant sections below).

BUS

There are many direct services from Piccadilly Bus Station and from south Manchester.

From Piccadilly Bus Station to south campus, buses include 15, 41, 42, 42A, 43, 44, 111, 142, 143 and 250.

From Piccadilly Bus Station to Victoria Park and Fallowfield via Upper Brook Street, buses 50 and 130.

The 147 service runs from Piccadilly Rail Station, www.route147.com

There are direct routes to south campus from Leigh, Atherton and Salford on the V1 and V2 services and from Middleton on the 18. From other parts of the city a change of bus may be required.

METROLINK TRAM

The closest tram stops are a walk or bus ride from the University (see the green 'M's' on the map above for stops).

CYCLING

There is a segregated cycle route along Oxford Road to south campus. The University provides numerous cycle parking facilities at key locations on both campuses. To plan your cycling journey visit www.tfgm.com/cycling

WALKING

There are designated pedestrian routes on campus and much of Manchester is relatively easy to get around on foot. It is 2 mins from Piccadilly Rail Station to north campus and 20/25 mins to south campus. Plan your walking route at www.walkit.com/cities/manchester

CAR

For sat nav or to plan your route by car, use the postcodes M1 3BB for north campus and M13 9PL for south campus.

New traffic priorities are in place for Oxford

Road. Only buses, hackney carriages, emergency vehicles and cyclists are able to travel along Oxford Road between 6am and 9pm, seven days-a-week. General traffic heading into the city centre from Wilmslow Road must now turn right onto Hathersage Road and continue their journey along the adjacent Upper Brook Street.

The University has several car parks with varying access restrictions and charges. More details on individual car parks is provided here but for disabled access information and further details go to: www.estates.manchester.ac.uk and click on 'car parks'

M62 (Eastbound), M602

Leave the M62 at J12 and join the M602. At the end of M602, join Regent Road (A57) and continue along and join the A57M (Mancunian Way). Leave at the second exit sign-posted A34 Congleton (hair-pin bend) and keep left, following signs for the Universities. Turn left onto the A34 (dual carriageway) and get in the right hand lane. Turn right at the first set of traffic lights into Grosvenor Street. Stay in the left hand lane and turn left at

the next set of traffic lights onto Oxford Road (B5117). Go straight on through the next set of traffic lights.

M62 (Westbound), M60

Leave M62 at J18 and join M60 ring road. Leave M60 at J22 and turn right at traffic lights onto Oldham Road (A62). Continue along until the end and turn left to join Great Ancoats Street (A665). Follow signs for the Universities and join the Mancunian Way (A57M). Leave at the second exit onto Higher Cambridge Street. Turn left at the next set of traffic lights onto Booth Street West and then turn right onto Oxford Road (B5117).

M6/M56

Leave the M6 at Junction 19 and turn right onto the A556. Follow signs for Manchester Airport and join the M56. Stay on M56 until it joins Princess Parkway (A5103). Continue for a further four miles before turning right at the Royal Brewery into Moss Lane East (B5219). Continue to the T-junction and turn left onto Oxford Road (B5117). Proceed down Oxford Road past the hospitals.
